Structure of the MFL Faculty



The MFL Faculty consists of 3 full-time specialist languages teachers. Currently all Year KS3 students have French twice a week. Sets one and two take up German alongside French in Year 8 and 9. MFL has a high profile within the school. Take up for GCSE is very good, most of our more able students are expected to study a GCSE in French or German. We have a small number of dual linguists in KS4. Our GCSE results are usually above national average (2020 FRENCH 24% 9-7, 80% 9-5, 100% 9-4, GERMAN 30% 9-7, 96% 9-5, 100% 9-4). The faculty also offers A Level French and German.

The faculty has 3 fully equipped teaching rooms and a small study room for sixth formers. We currently subscribe to Activeteach for our KS4 courses and are introducing this into KS3 (Dynamo and Stimmt textbooks). The faculty makes good use of other online learning and teaching resources.

We organise a Year 7 trip to France every year. We hope that the successful candidate would take an active role in helping to plan trips and attend as necessary.
