We are seeking to recruit a 1:1 Learning Support Assistant to work at Somerby Primary School with an engaging and delightful EYFS child, supporting him to work within his classroom environment.

Part time applications will be considered, working 8.30 am - 1pm, Monday - Friday, term time only (38 weeks plus 5 INSET days), 22 hours per week.

Full time applications will be considered, working 8:30am-3:30pm, Monday - Friday, term time only (38 weeks plus 5 INSET days), 32.5 hours per week.

You will be required to provide teaching and learning support for our EYFS child and associated activities under the direct supervision of the teacher. This may include providing general support for whole class learning activities, or supporting individuals, small groups of pupils or on a 1:1 basis.

Experience of working within a similar role with children and knowledge of Child Protection and Health and Safety policies are essential. Experience of delivering phonics to Key Stage 1 is desirable but full training will be given.

You will have an NVQ Level 2 in Supporting Teaching and Learning or equivalent. Level 2 qualifications in Maths and English would be desirable. Along with good interpersonal skills, you will be emphatic with children and young people, and be able to work effectively as part of our small but mighty team.
