Due to promotion, we are looking for two Assistant Headteachers to join our team and contribute to the strategic leadership of our school. You will be the strategic and operational lead for a phase of the school, as well as take on whole-school responsibilities (to be decided, but may include core subject leadership as well as other school-improvement priorities). Both posts involve a full-time teaching commitment, with weekly leadership time to fulfil your responsibilities.

These are key positions within our school and we would welcome candidates with exceptional leadership skills along with being highly motivated and an understanding of the challenges of an inner-city school.

#### About our School

Dorchester Primary School is a medium-sized school with around 300 children on roll. We are at the centre of our community and provide an education for children aged 3-11.

At our last Ofsted inspection (July 2021), we were judged as continuing to be GOOD, but we have aspirations to be even better.

We are at an exciting phase in our development, with the opening of a new SEND Unit in September (in collaboration with the Local Authority). We have made many improvements over the last few years, and standards continue to rise across the school.

We face many challenges: a falling pupil roll (meaning we are moving from a 1.5 to 1 form entry), a significantly higher percentage of pupils with an EHCP (over 3 times the national average), and ensuring that our curriculum continues to meet the needs of our pupils.

We have a large staff team and our pupils are supported by an expert team of support staff, who really do care about them. Pupil's well-being is at the forefront of our decision-making
