Purpose of role:

- 1. Improve student achievement in the area of English and Literacy, focusing particularly on reading.
- 2. Provide individual or small group instruction to students who do not have a reading age at least commensurate with their chronological age.
- 3. Monitor, report, and communicate student progress and performance to teachers, the Academy Leadership Team and students' parents and carers.
- 4. Provide training and support to teachers to help develop the capacity of teachers to improve students' reading.

Key accountabilities (and specific duties / responsibilities):

1.

- Provide high quality instruction to individual students and small groups.
- Be responsible for undertaking comprehensive assessments of students to; (i) determine those in need of particular support, and (ii) to target personalised interventions.
- Collaborate with teachers, SEN team and families to help identify best practices for individual and small groups of students.

2.

• Use identified research-based interventions focusing specifically on individual student needs.



- Provide diagnostic assessments for students as needed.
- Implement assessment tools and a data management system to assess the impact on the students.

3.

- Track and record student progress.
- Report students' progress to students, teachers, ALT and parents.
- Provide data-led options to inform decision making about next steps in reading provision.
- Communicate with teachers, school teams, and families regarding student progress.

4.

- Share evidence based approaches to improving students' reading.
- Provide 1-1 support to individual teachers to help them develop their capacity.
