- 4. To assist in the day to day organisation of the extended hours after school club.
- 5. To supervise children individually or in small groups as required.

- 7. To assist in preparing, serving and washing up at snack time.
- 8. To assist in maintaining, organising and sourcing resources.
- 9. To work outdoors regularly.
