Our curriculum is amazing, with a highly thought out sequenced two year rolling programme, ensuring that all children have access to all the learning and opportunities to support their understanding. WOW days at the start of the project work and SHOWCASE days at the end bring the learning to life, inviting families in to share in the experience. Throughout KS2 the children have one to one iPads which they access throughout the day for different activities and learning.
