Purpose of the Role:

To work with teachers to support teaching and learning, providing general and specific assistance to pupils and staff under the direction, guidance and direct supervision of the classroom teacher¹.

Main Tasks and Responsibilities

General Duties:

- To act in accordance with FCAT's policies and procedures.
- To act as a role model and work in accordance with the Trust values: pride, ambition, respect, resilience, integrity and excellence.
- To encourage and promote non-discriminatory behaviour and ensure equality and diversity is sustained within FCAT and our academies.
- To ensure compliance with the General Data Protection Regulations and maintain confidentiality in your working practices each day. To ensure compliance with FCAT's Health and Safety Policy at all times.
- To adhere to FCAT's Safeguarding policy and procedures to ensure that the duty of care for all staff, including yourself to protect children and young people is maintained.
- Any other tasks and responsibilities reasonably appropriate to this post and grade.
- To attend mandatory training and participate in performance development as required.
- To work in support of the Team FCAT Work and Wellbeing Charter.

Key duties:

- 1. Work with individuals or groups of pupils in the classroom under the direct supervision of teaching staff and provide feedback to the teacher;
- 2. Support pupils to understand instructions support independent learning and inclusion of all pupils;

- 3. Support the teacher in behaviour management and keeping pupils on task;
- 4. Support pupils in social, health and emotional well-being, reporting problems to the teacher as appropriate;
- 5. Prepare and clear up learning environment and resources, including photocopying, filing and the display and presentation of pupils work and contribute to maintaining a safe environment;
- 6. Responsible for the careful and safe use equipment, such as play and standard ICT equipment;
- 7. Maintain confidentiality and adhere to safeguarding procedures;
- 8. Demonstrate and adhere to the school's health and safety policies and procedures.

Teaching Assistants in this role may also:

- 1. Record basic pupil data;
- 2. Support children's learning through play;
- 3. Assist with break-time supervision including facilitating games and activities;
- 4. Assist with escorting pupils on educational visits;
- 5. Support pupils in using basic ICT;
- 6. Invigilate exams and tests;
- 7. Assist pupils with eating, dressing and hygiene, as required, whilst encouraging independence;
- 8. Demonstrate own duties to new or less experienced staff.

Skills required:

- 1. Good organisational skills.
- 2. Strong communication skills.
- 3. Ability to work off of your own initiative and also as part of a team.
- 4. Good interpersonal skills.
- 5. Good numeracy and literacy skills.

Qualifications required:

- 1. 4 GCSEs at grade A*-D (9-4) including Maths and English (or equivalent).
- 2. You must achieve at least a level I on the Initial Assessment that is completed during an Apprenticeship Selection Event at College.
