Job Description

Purpose

To assist in the delivery of our growing and successful Art and Design and Design and Technology qualifications. The role involves practical and technical support for these complex subjects, and would be highly rewarding for a creative, skilled and enthusiastic team player.

Role Responsibilities

- Art:
 - Clay preparation and recycling
 - Mixing of chemicals for clay glazes, textile devour and dyes
 - Managing the kiln loading and unloading after firings, checking health and safety
 - Overseeing cleanliness and maintenance of specialist equipment e.g. sewing machines, screens for screen printing, brushes

• Design and Technology:

- Support the teacher in monitoring and maintaining Design & Technology machinery and for ensuring safe usage of the machines (circular saw, band saw, laser cutter, Hegner saw, sanding machine, pillar drill, line bending machine, vacuum former, steam bender, gerbil, and hand tools)
- Support the teacher in for using the laser cutter and cutting students' work
- Undertaking preparation and follow-up work as requested, especially measurement, preparation and cutting of wood.

• Across Both Subjects

- Support with preparation for and delivery of lessons e.g. providing resources for teachers and students, setting up and helping to tidy rooms, assistance with equipment usage if required, overseeing safe usage by students.
- Maintaining appropriate stock levels within Art and D&T, and reporting any shortages to the department; assist with re-ordering if required.
- Overseeing tidiness and security of store-room cupboards in each subject, with appropriate regard for health and safety e.g. secure storage of chemicals, tools etc.
- Assisting with general upkeep and tidiness of classrooms and cupboards.
- Assisting with risk assessments and taking part in collective responsibility for their implementation.
- Assisting with display at annual arts exhibition.
- Contributing to health and safety across both departments.
- Support for equipment monitoring (cameras, tripods, lighting, sound kit) within Photography, Film Studies and Media Studies.

Personal Responsibilities:

• Hold positive values and attitudes and adopt high standards of professional conduct.



- Carry out the duties and responsibilities of the post, in accordance with the Trust's Health and Safety Policy and relevant Health and Safety Guidance and Legislation.
- Form positive professional relationships, and work in partnership with colleagues throughout TGAT.
- To willingly engage with training as required by the College.
- Treat all aspects of the role with the strictest confidentiality.

Any Special Conditions of Service:

- The post is subject to a satisfactory enhanced DBS background check, relevant right to work documentation, suitable references and a six -month probationary period

- Contribution to the overall ethos/work/aims of the Trust.
