The successful applicant will be required to teach full classes and groups of children. The start date for the post is September 2022.

The successful applicant will work according to the duties and conditions of employment laid down in the current school teachers' pay and conditions document, for the 1998 School Standards and Framework Act.

The post is subject to DBS checking and all referees will be required to disclose any disciplinary actions or concerns in relation to Safeguarding (Child Protection) matters. You are also legally required to disclose such information.

- Be motivated to enable children to enjoy and thrive in the creative arts
- Share knowledge and understanding of how the Arts contributes to other curriculum areas
- Set clear and challenging targets for each pupil based on prior attainment
- To assess children's work and progress rigorously
- To have high expectations of what each child can achieve and ensure that attainment matches potential
- To have excellent subject knowledge and awareness of the learning and pastoral needs of young pupils
- To liaise with colleagues and parents so as to ensure consistency of approach, standards and assessment
- To display strong team skills
- To hold positive values and attitudes in line with our Catholic ethos
- Organising the classroom and learning resources to create a positive learning environment
- Planning, preparing and presenting lessons that cater for all needs, especially the vulnerable
- Promoting positive behaviour in line with school policy

- Providing feedback to parents on a pupil's progress
- Staying up to date with changes and developments in the Arts
- Key contributor in school events and activities which may take place at weekends or in the evening
- Liaising with colleagues and working flexibly, including with our partner schools
- Working with parents and school governors to maximise their involvement in the school and the development of resources for the school
- Will provide extra out of school hours learning for groups of children
- Be willing to cover a class on occasion at the discretion of the Headteacher or Senior Leader
