

How do we support transition?

We fully understand that taking the step up to high school can be an anxious time for children and parents/carers alike. That's why at Durrington we go over and above to make the process as simple and straightforward as possible, for each and every one of you. From the moment you join our team, we commit to answering all questions (no matter how small) and also sharing with you the many things there are to look forward to. Creating this sense of excitement and opportunity goes a long way towards making transition smooth and successful.

Our specialist transition team, supported by company leaders, pastoral managers and the SEN(D) team make it their priority to get to know each and every student. Dividing the school into seven companies (each with around 235 students) ensures your child has a clear sense of identity and also security in knowing key members of staff know who they are, their likes and dislikes, goals and dreams.

We actively encourage parents/carers to be involved every step of the way, knowing from experience, that the closer we work with you the easier the transition will be.

Daily life at Durrington begins at 8.45am with period one; a 30-minute tutor time with their form group within which the children undertake a variety of different activities including tutor-led discussions on current affairs and issues, community challenges and much more. As well as learning this gives time to build strong relationships between your child, their tutor and peers. It ensures a really positive start to the day.

The rest of the day is spent in 5 subject lessons and 2 break times (during which there are plentiful opportunities to attend clubs, eat and socialise). Year 7 students have a canteen, social area and a set of toilets dedicated for their use only; facilities which they can use as much or as little as they like.




Pupils' behaviour is excellent and they wear their uniform with pride. They are kind and respectful towards each other and their teachers.

We are immensely proud of all our year 11 students who showed such resilience and worked so hard to achieve a great set of GCSE results in the summer. As a school our results are consistently strong and we strive year on year to improve these further. This year more students than ever before achieved grade 5s or higher in both English and Maths GCSE and an incredible 257 grade 9s were awarded.


