Job Description



Job title: Art Technician

Reports to: Director of Learning Location: The Leigh Academy

Main Purpose

To support the teaching and learning of students within the Art department and provide support and services to the staff and students in line with the Academy policies and procedures.

Key Responsibilities

- To organise practical support for Art teaching in the Academy
- To maintain resources and equipment
- To have an oversight of Health & Safety within the art studios
- To provide equipment and materials to support art practical teaching
- To take responsibility for stock maintenance, control and safekeeping
- To prepare equipment and materials for practical lessons, and remove it safely afterwards
- To clean equipment and keep the art studios in good order
- To order stock, check deliveries and organise stock cupboard
- To purchase items from petty cash when required
- To prepare visual aids for teaching staff
- To put up and maintain art displays around the Academy
- To prepare displays for open evenings and help out as appropriate
- To assist in the classroom with students during ceramics activities
- To arrange all the photocopying needs of the department
- To assist with stock control of books, paper and non-specific art items
- To maintain the kiln, including packing and operating a variety of firings
- To assist with any other task reasonably requested

Safeguarding of students and Duty of care

All staff, regardless of role, level of seniority and location, have a responsibility to ensure the highest levels of safeguarding and promoting the welfare of our pupils, and we expect all our staff and volunteers to share this commitment.
