Role Profile

Working as part of a committed and collegial Senior Leadership Team (SLT), this will be a key role in the strategic leadership of the Curriculum and associated assessment strategy. As the lead professional you will ensure that our curriculum continues to be ambitious, knowledge rich and culturally broad and meets the needs of our cohorts year on year. You will lead the annual curriculum review process and work with middle leaders to assess its impact on our learners, both in terms of engagement and outcomes. You will also be responsible for aligning the whole school assessment strategy to the curriculum and work closely with middle leaders to create a strong culture of using assessment data strategically to inform curriculum decisions and address gaps in pupil knowledge. Working closely with the Assistant Head Teaching and Learning, you will carry out subject reviews, addressing any in-school variation through strategic improvement planning and implementation. The operational elements of this role will require you to work closely with our data and examinations officers, as well as the timetabler.

You will be able to role model the required Teaching Standards and be able to demonstrate leadership with integrity, accountability and honesty. You will be a team player who pulls in the right direction and works collegially with the Senior Leadership Team to meet our school improvement priorities.

You will be an effective classroom practitioner, have strong data analysis skills and be a strategic thinker who is able to 'think outside of the box' to arrive at curriculum solutions that work given the resource constraints of a smaller than average secondary school. You will be a confident presenter and be able to gain the confidence and respect of middle leaders and teaching staff.

- Report headline data and trends to the headteacher and the Trust.
