Currently the role is not class based but does involve some cover teaching across Nursery, Reception and Key Stage 1. This is a key role in our leadership team and a chance to lead a larger than average EYFS and Key Stage 1 provision.

Westways had a Good judgement at the last Ofsted inspection in December 2018. Since then the school has continued to improve still further.

We are a Read Write Inc. school and are proud of our high quality phonics teaching. The successful candidate will be expected to lead early reading and phonics teaching across EYFS and Key Stage 1 and provide support and advice to secure strong reading transition into Key Stage 2.

This role would suit a teacher with experience of leading EYFS or Key Stage 1 with a secure knowledge of the EYFS and Key Stage 1 curriculum as well as EYFS baseline assessments, Year 1 phonics screening check and Key Stage 1 SATs.
