Our academy provides a unique opportunity to teach both key stage two and key stage three children. We work with children age 9 - 13 years (Y5 - Y8) and this age ranges enables us to put the curriculum at the heart of what we do. There are no national tests or exams at the end of key stage three and this empowers teachers to focus on driving a broad and balanced curriculum. As a teacher you will be surrounded by professionals from a range of backgrounds including both primary and secondary training. Teachers share a pedagogical practice with each other and there is a genuine sense of a learning community.

Our aim is to ensure that the highest quality teaching of a broad, balanced and challenging curriculum in a stimulating environment, each pupil flourishes. With an excellent pastoral care system, we foster an environment where children feel safe and able to learn. We are a community that values each child and provides them with the opportunity to fulfil their potential and enjoy learning. We believe in building a child's confidence, adaptability and resilience for the future within an ordered and structured environment, where high expectations are a habit.
