- Achieve outstanding practice through the challenge and motivation of others
- Have high expectations of achievement and behaviour
- Be able to play a crucial role in developing, managing and leading across school

- Lead in key areas across the whole school, such as: the development of Teaching and Learning, as well as play a strong role in safeguarding and the Health and Safety of the school
