### Nishkam High School

The post holder will report to the school Principal and will create the capacity for the Principal to be able to serve in the broader Trust role of Deputy Chief Executive Officer.

This is an excellent opportunity for significant career development at a senior level. It is ideal for an existing Vice Principal (Deputy Headteacher), providing a 'bridge' between that role and sole responsibility for a school. That transition will be supported by an existing Principal who has been in post for over six years and has implemented the Trust's 'faith inspired, virtues led' vision. The impact of that vision is reflected in a Section 5, Ofsted 'outstanding' judgement, a Section 48 'outstanding' judgement and the performance data shown, below.
