

Job Title: Breakfast Club Assistant

Main Duties and responsibilities

Delivering Breakfast Club provision:

- To help plan, deliver and evaluate a varied programme of high-quality play opportunities in a safe environment.
- To follow safeguarding and health & safety policies and procedures at all times
- To help in the development of independent social skills
- To undertake duties such as preparing snacks, cleaning the play areas and toys, reporting any damages and tidying up etc.
- To report a child's problems/achievements to the head teacher as necessary
- To administer basic first aid where appropriately trained
- To notice when stock needs replenishing and alert Club Manager
- To assist in the specific medical/care needs of pupils when specific training has been undertaken
- To take care for their own and other people's health and safety.
- To assist in Club marketing and promotion
- To support the promotion of positive relationships with parents including communicating effectively with parents on a regular basis
- To ensure confidentiality is maintained where appropriate

In addition, other duties at the same responsibility level may be interchanged with/added to this list following discussion between yourself and your line manager
