9. PROTECTION OF CH	ILDREN				

The Sikh Academies Trust is required under law and guidance to check the criminal background of all employees. Decisions to appoint will be subject to consideration of an enhanced disclosure, including a Barred List check, from the Disclosure and Barring Service. Because of the nature of the work for which you are applying, this post is exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions)

Order 1975 (as amended in 2013 and 2020).

The amendments to the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975 (2013 and 2020) provides that when applying for certain jobs and activities, certain convictions and cautions are

considered 'protected'. This means that they do not need to be disclosed to employers, and if they are disclosed, employers cannot take them into account.

so that a police check can be carried out if you are offered an appointment.

If you are short-listed for an interview, in line with Keeping Children Safe in Education we will also ask you to complete a self-declaration form prior to interview to provide any relevant information which may make you unsuitable to work with children. For example, whether you are included on the barred list, prohibited from teaching, prohibited from taking part in the management of an independent school, known to the police and children's social care or disqualified from providing childcare and any relevant overseas information.

If you are subsequently employed by the Sikh Academies Trust and it is found that you failed to disclose any relevant previous convictions, cautions or other relevant information as defined above, this could result in dismissal, or disciplinary action being taken by the Sikh Academies Trust. During the course of your employment with the Sikh Academies Trust, should you be arrested by the police you are obliged to notify the Headteacher of this immediately (even if de-arrested or all charges dropped). Failure to do so could result in disciplinary action being taken which could result in dismissal. All information will be treated in confidence and will only be considered in relation to any application for posts for which the exemption order applies.

It is an offence for anyone to apply for a role if they are barred from engaging in regulated activity relevant to children.
