- Ability to assess and record progress
- Knowledge of the statutory requirements for assessment and reporting outcomes
- Good interpersonal and organisational skills
- Good humoured, friendly and approachable manner with the ability to relate well to children and adults in a variety of situations
- Ability to work under own initiative and be flexible in approaching work
- A reflective practitioner with a commitment to undertake continuing professional development resulting in positive impact on own practice.
- Work constructively as part of a team, understanding classroom roles and responsibilities and your own position within these
- Ability to communicate effectively with parents and other professionals and to maintain confidentiality with information received regarding pupils and families
- Knowledge and understanding of safeguarding and Child Protection procedures
- Effective and creative use of technological , computing and other aids to support learning
- Self - motivated and ambitious with the ability to motivate and inspire others

- Understanding of wider primary curriculum across EYFS, KS1 & 2
- Experience of monitoring, moderating, reviewing and reporting pupil outcomes and progress
