

TLR 2a Job Description: Leader of Science and Technology (STEM)

Job Purpose

To teach pupils within the primary age range, 4 – 11.

Impact positively on pupil achievement and curriculum progression.

Responsibilities

1. Teaching Duties

- create a stimulating learning environment that reflects current evidence and research on how children learn
- plan, teach, review and evaluate all aspects of teaching and learning in relation to pupil knowledge and pedagogy
- work collaboratively with colleagues to ensure progression across all subjects
- take into account the learning needs of all pupils
- assess, record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils
- promote the well-being of all pupils and nurture relationships that reflect our school values
- maintain positive relationships and good conduct among pupils; ensuring safeguarding and health and safety procedures are followed
- work in partnership with parents to share learning and communicate progress.

2. Other Professional Duties

- participate in the Performance Management process
- embrace professional learning opportunities and be a role model for colleagues
- build relationships and work in partnership with education, professional and community groups/ organisations to support professional learning and school improvement
- lead and support teaching and learning professional development opportunities.

3. Additional Responsibilities

3.1 Work in partnership with the Deputy Headteacher to develop STYEM across school.

3.2 Work with colleagues to:

- lead and develop learning and teaching in STEM subject areas
- evaluate the impact of school improvement priorities
- analyse school data to identify next steps for school improvement
- track the progress of cohorts and target groups of pupils
- monitor progression across a subject area
- model and implement teaching strategies to enable effective implementation of the curriculum
- lead and participate in educational research in response to school improvements priorities
- support the induction of new staff and new subject leaders
- support staff to manage resources and budget allocations.
