

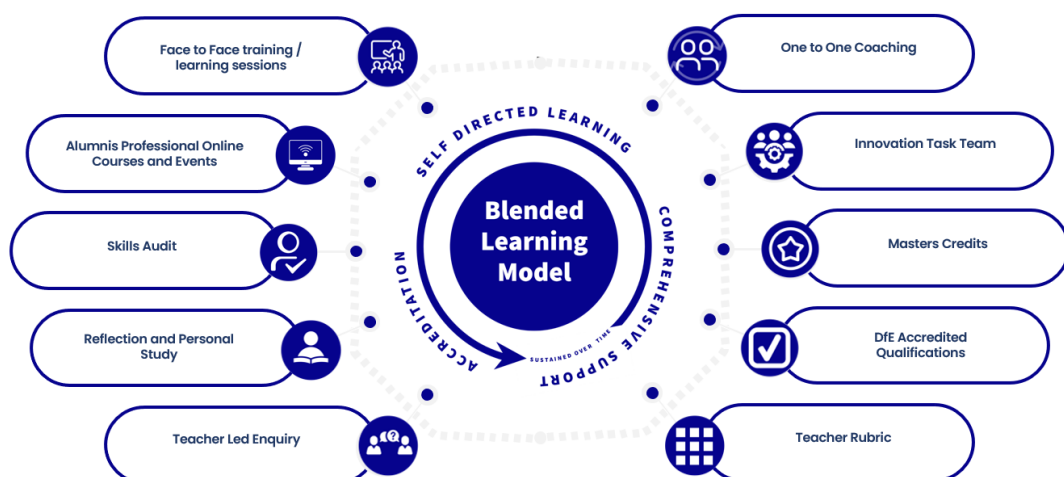
Your Professional Learning

Our Alumnis family is proud to be set in the most beautiful part of the country (in our opinion!). Devon is a wonderful place to live and a fantastic place to bring up children. Our schools are at the heart of the communities that we serve.

Webber's school is situated in rural Devon with easy access to Tiverton Parkway mainline Station, the M5 and North Devon Link Road. Both north and south Devon coasts are within an hour's drive as well as Exmoor (home to Europe's first Dark Sky Reserve), Dartmoor, Bristol and Plymouth.

As well as our Devon beaches and moorlands, there are a number of other places to enjoy your evening and weekend strolls. Most towns and villages have green spaces and there are networks of public footpaths and bridleways across the county. The Grand Western Canal Country Park and Local Nature Reserve meanders for 11.25 miles through beautiful countryside and quiet villages between the market town of Tiverton and the hamlet of Lowdwells (near the Somerset border) offering scenic, peaceful and traffic-free walking and cycling routes.

You'll also find many local football, rugby, running, gymnastics, dance and drama clubs to join. Weekly park runs are held at many local locations including Killerton, Exeter Riverside and, for a seaside run, Seaton.
