The person appointed will:

- Have Qualified Teacher Status
- Have experience of Primary teaching- Specifically key stage 1
- Be committed to improving standards in learning and have high expectations for all children
- Be able to use knowledge gained through day to day assessment to meet children's learning needs and ensure personalised learning and progression through pitched activities/tasks
- Experience in planning for success criteria (Learning outcomes) and a commitment to assessment for learning.
- Be able to engage children in learning
- Be able to manage children's behaviour effectively to ensure that a positive classroom work ethic prevails
- Demonstrate a commitment to making a strong contribution to the ethos and aims of the school as a team member
- Be friendly, caring and approachable to all stakeholders
- Be proficient in the use of ICT
- Have a creative, dynamic and flexible approach to teaching and learning
- Display a commitment towards safe-guarding young people
- Require an enhanced DBS completed and submitted by the school prior to appointment
- Have appropriate references
- Be able to demonstrate relevant qualifications by producing certificates.

Desirable:

The person appointed may be able to:

- Have experience of leading a curriculum subject across the whole school
- Demonstrate experience of accurate assessment of children's learning
- Demonstrate knowledge of whole class guided reading, maths mastery and Oracy approaches to teaching and learning
- Demonstrate knowledge of research informed practice
- Join activities both during and outside the school day
