Dear Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in the Class Teacher post presently being advertised at Fell Dyke.

Fell Dyke is an ambitious and rapidly improving school who wish to appoint an excellent teacher into a permanent post from September 2023. We are a 1.5 form entry school and currently have around 290 children on roll, including nursery. We are looking for a teacher who, in future years, would be flexible and open to working in other year groups.

Staff work together closely in each phase to support one another to meet the needs of all children in their class. There are several children across school with Education and Health Care Plans, who receive 1:1 support from TAs. We have a large team of excellent teaching assistants. Establishing good relationships with all colleagues and being proactive in quickly developing a high-quality professional dialogue focussed on learning are both very important to us.

Curriculum development is a well-established yet ongoing process for all teaching staff in our school. We expect staff to be willing and able to support with whole school improvement, through excellent foundation subject leadership and being proactive in raising the profile of their subject across all phases.

Continuing personal and professional development is high on our agenda. A full and detailed in-service training programme is developed for all staff each year. Recently qualified and experienced staff alike are very well supported. We expect that parents, staff and governors work together in the spirit of partnership and we strive constantly to improve our provision for the benefit of our community.

The school site is large and facilities for learning are extensive. We have plenty of space in school for working with children, a large playground and MUGA, forest school area and a substantial school field.
