- Support the development of pupils' literacy and numeracy, including systematic synthetic phonics and early maths (as appropriate).

Pupil Progress

- Assess, track and monitor pupil progress, using data to inform next steps.
- Provide timely and constructive feedback, both orally and through marking.
- Set and review targets in line with school assessment practices.
- Be accountable for the attainment and progress of pupils in your care.

Classroom Environment and Behaviour

- Maintain high expectations for behaviour and apply the school's behaviour policy consistently.
- Develop positive relationships with pupils rooted in mutual respect.
- Create a learning environment that supports pupil engagement and independence.
- Use rewards and sanctions fairly and consistently.

- Work collaboratively with colleagues and engage in team planning.
