Teaching and Learning Responsibility

General

Teachers receiving Teaching and Learning Responsibility Payments provide professional leadership and management for their school/subject area(s) to secure high quality teaching, effective use of resources and improved standards of learning and achievement for all pupils. (Ref TTA Standard) They are accountable for a significant, specified responsibility focused on teaching and learning, that is not required of all classroom teachers. (Ref STRB/RIG) TLR's are permanent awards but may be withdrawn if the responsibility were removed, either through agreement or as a result of capability procedures or following restructuring.

Factors to apply to the awarding of a payment:

- Impact on educational progress beyond the teacher's assigned pupils
- Leading, developing and enhancing the teaching practice of others
- Having accountability for leading managing and developing the curriculum area(s) or pupil development across the curriculum
- Potentially having line management responsibility for others if required
