Title: Class Teacher

Responsible to: Headteacher

Purpose: To facilitate and encourage learning which enables children to achieve high standards; to share and support the corporate responsibility for the well-being and education of all children.

The post holder will be expected to undertake duties in line with the Teaching Standards for qualified teachers and uphold these standards in addition to the professional code of the National College for Teaching and Leadership for England.

- Maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of the professional duties of teachers and the statutory framework within which they work.
- Have high expectations of children and a commitment to ensuring that they can achieve their full educational potential.
- Have a good, up-to-date working knowledge and understanding of a range of teaching, learning and behaviour management strategies and know how to use and adapt them, including how to personalise learning to provide opportunities for all learners to achieve their potential.
- Plan for progression across the age and ability range they teach, designing effective learning sequences within lessons and across series of lessons informed by secure subject/curriculum knowledge.
- Teach challenging, well-organised lessons and sequences of lessons across the Primary Phase and ability range designed to raise levels of attainment.
- Employ a range of approaches to assessment and be able to use local and national statistical information to evaluate the effectiveness of their teaching.
- Make effective use of an appropriate range of observation, assessment, monitoring and recording strategies as a basis for setting challenging learning objectives and monitoring learners' progress and levels of attainment.
- Establish a purposeful and safe learning environment which complies with current legal requirements, national policies and guidance on the safeguarding and well-being of children and young people so that learners feel secure and sufficiently confident to make an active contribution to learning and to the school.
- Work as a team member and identify opportunities for working with colleagues, managing work where appropriate and sharing the development of effective practice with them.
- Have a creative approach towards innovation; being prepared to adapt practice where benefits and improvements are identified.
- Communicate effectively with children, parents and carers conveying timely and relevant information about attainment, objectives, progress and well-being.
- Promote safeguarding through all actions and interactions
- Meet the requirements of the Teaching Standards at the appropriate level expected by the school.
