- Manage behaviour effectively to ensure a safe and productive learning environment.
- Set high expectations for every pupil and lead by example in all areas of work.
- Follow the school's policies and procedures consistently.
- Work well with the Local Academy Committee, parents, staff, and other schools.
- Manage and use support staff and resources effectively within the key stage.
- Meet deadlines in a timely manner.
