General Background

Landewednack CP School is a small school of 80 children from age 2 to 11, located in the village of The Lizard, twelve miles from Helston; we are the most southerly school in mainland Britain.

Our guiding principles are academic success, a supportive family ethos and being at the heart of our local community.

Class Organisation

The school has 4 classes:

‘Little Lizards’ nursery (aged 2 to 4)

‘Puffins’ (Reception & Year 1)

‘Choughs’ (Year 2, 3 & 4)

‘Razorbills’ (Year 5 & 6)

Safeguarding

TPAT is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and expects all staff, workers, volunteers, governors and trustees to share this commitment.

All criminal convictions must be declared. Failure to do so may result in your application being disqualified or, if discovered after appointment, may be regarded as grounds for dismissal.
