

## **Class Teacher Job Description**

## **Key Purpose**

- To believe in and promote the aims and ethos of the school.
- To deliver high quality teaching and learning to pupils who are assigned to the post holder.

## **Main Duties:**

All teachers work within the statutory conditions of employment set out in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document and the Teacher Standards. The duties listed below are not, therefore, an exhaustive list of what is required.

- Be responsible for the quality of teaching and learning of all pupils who are assigned to the post holder.
- Set consistently high expectations which inspire, motivate and challenge pupils.
- Promote good progress and outcomes by all pupils.
- Demonstrate excellent subject and curriculum knowledge.
- Plan and teach well-structured lessons.
- Adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of all pupils.
- Make accurate and productive use of assessment and marking in line with school policy.
- Manage behaviour effectively to ensure a safe learning environment.
- Provide pastoral care and support for all pupils assigned to post holder.
- Supervise and guide the work of any support staff who are assigned to work with the post holder's pupils.
- Make a positive contribution to the wider life of the school.
- Develop professional relationships with colleagues.
- Take responsibility for own professional development; using this effectively to improve own practice.
- Have a shared responsibility for the safeguarding of all pupils.

## **Review of Duties:**

The specific duties attached to any individual teacher are subject to annual review and may, after discussion with the teacher, be changed.
