Job Title: Class Teacher

Responsible to: Headteacher and Key Stage Co-ordinator

**Job Purpose:** as a member of the whole staff team, take responsibility for the effective teaching and pupils' progress and achievement.

### **Objectives:**

The class teacher is expected to:

- manage an effective classroom
- ensure that each pupil reaches the highest level of attainment
- liaise with key stage and curriculum manager to ensure effective teaching and learning within the classroom
- use TA support productively to raise pupil achievement.

### Areas of Responsibilities and Key Tasks

## Teaching, learning and the curriculum

- 1. to plan and prepare lessons that conform to the requirements of the national curriculum
- 2. to teach assigned groups of pupils to the highest standards according to their educational needs, including
  - setting and marking work carried out by the pupil in school and elsewhere
- 3. to assess, record and report pupil progress and attainment in line with school policy
- 4. to work with colleagues to ensure that curriculum plans form part of a coherent strategy for raising pupil
  - achievement across the curriculum
- 5. to prepare and present informative reports to parents
- 6. to maintain good order and discipline among pupils and safeguard their health and safety
- 7. to be sensitive to the pastoral needs of pupils in the school
- 8. to create a pleasant effective and safe learning environment.
- 9. to advise the key stage and curriculum co-ordinators regarding the need for new resources.
- 10. to maintain existing resources and explore opportunities to develop new learning opportunities for pupils.

#### Professional Knowledge and Understanding

- 1. to ensure personal professional development by attending INSET relevant to the needs of the SDP and your own personal targets
- 2. to participate in any arrangements within a nationally agreed framework for the appraisal of teachers
- 3. to participate in meetings at school which relate to the curriculum, administration or organisation of the school (including pastoral arrangements).
