Essential:

Qualified teacher
Other relevant continuing professional development

Desirable:

Additional relevant qualifications such as higher degree, certificate or diploma

Experience

Essential:

Recent experience as a highly effective teacher
Experience of using performance data, target setting and assessment for learning to raise achievement
Detailed knowledge of the National Curriculum and recent developments in pedagogy

Desirable:

Teaching in a Catholic school
Teaching a multi-ethnic and multi-lingual context
Experience in teaching pupils with special educational needs and disabilities

Skills and Abilities

Essential:

Committed to meeting the needs of pupils
Makes best use of resources
Prioritises, plans and organises work
A collaborative practitioner with good listening skills and willingness to learn
Understanding of appropriate strategies for managing pupils' behaviour
Ability to develop positive working relationships with pupils, staff, parents, governors, and the local community
Excellent communication skills both orally and in writing
