<b>Job Title</b>	Class Teacher
<b>Phase</b>	KS1 or KS2
<b>Responsible to</b>	The Headteacher
<b>Purpose of Role</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>To take on the full role of class teacher with full responsibility for the teaching and learning of a class.</li></ul>
<b>Main Responsibilities</b>	<p><i>General</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>To carry out the professional duties of a teacher as identified in the current Pay and Conditions Document, as circumstances may require, under the direction of the Head teacher</li><li>To uphold the Teachers Standards at all times</li><li>To be prepared to lead a subject area (for Early Career Teachers this is likely to be supporting another teacher in a subject area)</li></ul> <p><i>Teaching and Curriculum</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>To ensure thorough assessment details are maintained for individual pupils and the whole class in accordance with agreed whole school procedures</li><li>Develop a range of teaching skills which address school and national issues such as SEN, EAL, Pupil Premium, Summer born pupils, more able, Looked After Children and vulnerable children and enhance the thinking and independent skills of all pupils including the promotion of the 4Rs and Growth Mindset (see school website for details) and our philosophy of 'Achievement for All, Guided by God'</li><li>Showing commitment to your further training and CPD as a teacher</li></ul>

### *Pupils and Assessment*

- Promoting, and monitoring the educational, social, emotional, behaviour, health and economic well-being of all pupils in order for them to make a positive contribution to society

- Making records of and reports on personal and social needs of pupils
- To contribute to regular pupil progress meetings and develop a deep understanding of the needs of the pupils in your class
