Dear Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in the position of Class teacher at our school. We hope that you enjoy looking through the information provided, and that you decide to apply to join our great team.

West Hampstead Primary is a two-form entry school with space for 446 pupils, from Nursery to Year 6. Over the past few years the roll has been increasing, with Reception being full up for the past 6 years. In September 2026 we are anticipating another full Reception, therefore the school will be close to capacity. We are very proud of this achievement!

The Nursery which has 30 pupils, is seen as an integral part of the school. West Hampstead Primary draws pupils from a socially and culturally diverse local community. Around 40 languages are spoken by pupils and their families representing over 60 countries. The main languages spoken, other than English, are Somali, Bengali and Albanian.

West Hampstead Primary School is housed in a pleasant Victorian three-storey (listed) building with plenty of light and the space to accommodate 13 classrooms to fit 30 children and a further 3 to fit up to 20 children as well as a resources room, music room, staff room and several smaller teaching rooms. The school grounds have been developed and provide three adventure playgrounds, a football pitch, a sports area, a quiet zone and a garden area. The school is well served by public transport with bus, rail and Underground links. It is situated in an attractive residential area within walking distance of local shops, restaurants and cafes.

We include children with a wide range of abilities and needs, including those who are exceptionally able and those who have learning difficulties and statements of special educational needs. The school is fully accessible. Our staff have a positive attitude towards inclusion and are highly trained and highly skilled.

The rich diversity of our pupil intake is both stimulating and challenging for staff, in terms of the skills required in the classroom, and the priorities expressed by parents. Many parents take an active interest in their children's education, are in regular contact with staff and give us a great deal of support and encouragement. This is a healthy partnership which the school encourages. There is a lively and involved Governing Body, where many members are also parents. The school also works closely with neighbouring schools.

We are well provided with resources for teaching across the curriculum. The school budget is supplemented by funds raised by our active PSA, which also arranges enjoyable social events. Visits to a



wide range of local venues and those which are further afield are frequently made in order to support learning across the curriculum. Likewise, we invite visitors from such venues to the school.

We have 18 teachers which includes the Deputy Head, Assistant Head/SENDco and Assistant Head/Curriculum Phase. We also have a PE instructor who works with classes throughout the school. We have a large inclusion team made up of a team of Learning Support Assistants who support pupils in class and 4 inclusion learning support assistants who support pupils with EAL and lead interventions. We also have 2 site staff and three office staff. Children receive a variety of instrumental tuition on the premises from self-employed staff.

Our staff are a mixture of people who have worked in the school over an extended period, as well as those who are less experienced and recently appointed. Staff members are lively, friendly, supportive and committed and between them have an impressive range of skills and a great sense of humour.

West Hampstead Primary is a thriving school serving a wonderful community. We are a school committed to inclusion and our ethos pervades everything we do. We have high expectations of our pupils both in terms of attainment and behaviour. We respect and welcome the diversity in our community as well as thinking of ourselves as one big family.

We are looking for talented staff to join our school. We are also seeking to recruit individuals who are keen to continue developing their learning and skills. You will receive excellent CPD opportunities to develop your career through a supportive and outstanding team, as well as bespoke training to meet your individual needs. Our Maths Lead is the NCETM Primary Maths Lead for London Central and NW, therefore we provide many opportunities for Maths CPD.



We are part of the Challenge Partners network of schools and in our recent review we were deemed to be 'Leading' in all areas, with a further accredited 'Area of Excellence' for Maths.
