A Class Teacher will:

 - Be responsible for the supervision of Teaching Assistants
 - Provide support and management of pupils within a caring ethos in accordance with school policies and procedures, including the Child Safeguarding/Protection procedures.
 - Foster positive relationships with parents, and be involved in home/school liaison, as appropriate,
 - Liaise and work in collaboration with therapists and other colleagues/professionals

- Attend and contribute to case conferences as appropriate, as may be directed by the Head Teacher
- Take part in the arrangements for Appraisal
- The job description will be reviewed annually as part of the Appraisal cycle
