We are a primary and secondary multi academy trust based in Leicestershire

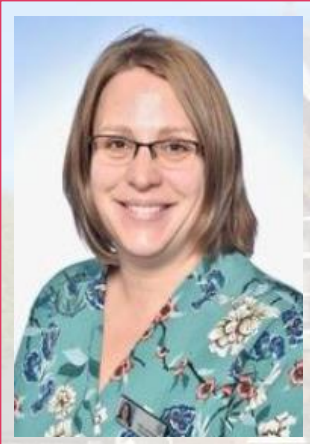
