HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are required to submit a letter of application and complete a Support Staff Application Form. When completing your application please note the following important points:

- i) Letters of application should be no more than 2 sides of A4.
- ii) The application form must be completed clearly and in full, handwritten or typed is acceptable. It is very important to complete all of your employment history since leaving secondary education.
- iii) We are unable to process any applications stating "see CV".
- iv) The declaration on the application form must be signed.
