<u>Purpose of the Post:</u>	To undertake cleaning within the school according to procedures & codes, using a variety of methods including machinery and adhering to safety regulations

<u>Main Duties and Responsibilities:</u>	▪ To carry out cleaning in all and any areas of the school. You may work within the swimming pool area, therefore the ability to swim would be preferable but not essential ▪ To carry out as necessary the replacement of paper towels, renewing supply of toilet rolls and replacement of bin liners ▪ To undertake training in the correct use of cleaning equipment such as floor machines, Vacs, wets pick-ups and in health and safety, the use of cleaning chemicals ▪ To notify the Cleaner Team Leader or other senior member of staff, of any damage to buildings and equipment or of anything you see that may be dangerous to pupils and/or staff ▪ To show a responsible attitude to health and safety issues and to have due regard for your personal safety and that of others ▪ To participate in the performance review process, taking personal responsibility for identification of learning, development and training opportunities in discussion with your line manager ▪ To comply with individual responsibilities, in accordance with the role, for health and safety in the workplace ▪ Such other duties relating to the cleanliness of the school premises as may be necessary from time to time within the reasonable requirements of the Headteacher and Governing Body
