Basic Job Purpose:

Undertake the cleaning of designated areas within the School.

General Tasks

1. To clean areas of the establishment as directed by the Cleaning Supervisor or Site Manager to ensure that the areas are kept in a clean and hygienic condition.
2. Duties will include cleaning, washing, sweeping, vacuum cleaning, emptying of litter bins, polishing and dusting of the areas, which may include toilets, shower areas, fixtures and fittings, using, where appropriate, powered equipment.
3. To operate cleaning machinery in accordance with instructions and report faulty machinery and equipment to the Site Manager.
