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Core Purpose

To ensure the designated area is cleaned to appropriate specification as directed by the Academy and in accordance with Health and Safety requirements

Main Responsibilities

The responsibilities of this role could vary as a result of new legislation, changes in technology or policy changes. This job description is not an exhaustive list of tasks of the role.

- Empty waste bins and dispose of collection bags safely
- Wash, clean and polish floors using appropriate machinery and cleaning agents
- Wipe down, dust and polish furniture in a careful and thorough manner, checking tables and chairs for any damage likely to cause injury.
- Undertake a deep clean during holiday periods, including washing walls, furniture and fixtures
- Operate a safe working environment for people still in the building (display appropriate safety signs etc.)
- Maintain the cleaning storage area in a clean, tidy and safe condition
- Maintain records of use of equipment and materials as required by the Academy, and/or COSHH
- Report faults in equipment to the appropriate person in the Academy as soon as possible

Other Duties

- To attend mandatory training courses, e.g., Child Protection, Equal Opportunities and Health and Safety related courses
- To promote and celebrate an approach of equality, diversity and inclusion for all colleagues, students and external stakeholders.
- Responsible for the health and safety of themselves and others
- Responsible for the safeguarding of and promotion of wellbeing for both children and colleagues
- To be a team player and contribute towards the vision, culture and ethos of the Trust
- From time to time you may be required to carry out other duties commensurate with the role.
