Job Purpose:			The cleaning of designated areas within a variety of premises, in accordance with the cleaning schedule, to ensure that they are kept clean and hygienic.		

## Main responsibilities

The following is typical of the duties the post holder will be expected to perform. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar nature and level may be required from time to time.

To undertake the cleaning of designated areas, in accordance with agreed specifications and including fixtures and fittings, including:-

- Emptying waste bins and removing waste to the designated area
- Washing with mops and cloths
- Sweeping with brushes and sweeping mops
- Vacuum cleaning
- Floor polishing/buffing/spray cleaning using mechanical aids as appropriate
- Floor stripping using mechanical aids as appropriate
- Dusting
