Are you someone who is passionate about deaf education and would like to be part of a team supporting a deaf child reach their potential in a mainstream primary setting? We currently have a vacancy for a Communication Support Worker to join us.

You will receive child specific training from the Inclusion Service's, Teacher of the Deaf to enable you to skillfully support this child using a range of communication methods, including Sign Supported English (SSE).

You will be working with a range of professionals including class teachers, the school Senco and the Teacher of the Deaf. In order to support this child's achievement, you will also be required to prepare visual resources (e.g. adapting the teaching material to ensure it is accessible). In addition to in-class support, you will also be required to support the child with individual learning activities as specified by the class teacher and the Teacher of the Deaf.



About the candidate

We are looking for someone who has experience of working with young children, preferably within a Primary education environment. You need to have the requisite signing skills (BSL Signature Level 3, or Level 2 and be prepared to work towards Level 3) and be familiar with Sign Supported English. Knowledge of hearing loss and hearing technology would be beneficial though training will be given.
