OVERALL PURPOSE OF JOB

To supervise classes, deliver pre-planned work and be responsible for the learning, behaviour and progress of students during the absence of the designated teacher

MA	MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES		
1	Supervise whole classes during the absence of the class teacher, including the delivery of pre-set work, responding to questions and helping students to undertake set activities		
2	Maintain good standards of behaviour, utilising the school's behaviour management system		
3	Liaise with relevant colleagues as appropriate before and/or after the lesson regarding lesson content and/or students whose learning or conduct give cause for specific praise or concern		
4	Monitor and respond to student learning and behaviour at all times by making adjustments to the delivery of the pre-planned content and/or learning activities, and ensuring differentiated delivery where specified in the cover work provided, ensuring awareness of any individual student needs (e.g. as per EHCPs or other student plans)		
5	Manage resources effectively and ensure classrooms are left tidy and ready for the next lesson		
6	Take part in relevant school meetings as required		
7	Establish working relationships and communicate with other agencies/professionals, in liaison with the teacher, to support the achievement and progress of students		



8	Assist with the supervision of students out of lesson time, including before and after school and at break and lunch times
9	Supervise students on visits, trips and out-of-school activities as required
10	When not required to undertake cover, provide support either in class or by providing clerical/admin support, e.g. photocopying, filing, supporting colleagues in the preparation of resources, displays and other support materials
11	Supervise pupils and provide access arrangements for students sitting internal and external examinations, ensuring compliance with examination board regulations
12	Undertake the duties of a first aider as and when required
