In periods where cover is not required, the successful candidate will support in the classroom as directed. This role will also support the school during the exam periods. We are looking for someone who can effectively work under the guidance of teaching staff and within an agreed system of supervision, to implement work programmes with individuals/groups in or out of the classroom including the supervision of whole classes during the short-term absence of teachers. You will manage the behaviour of students in line with the Trust's Behaviour Policy. The position is an ideal opportunity for someone wishing to pursue a career in education.
