

JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: School Crossing Patrol

Grade: TPLT SS1

Academy: West Huntspill Primary School Academy

Main purpose of the role

To ensure the safety of children crossing the road at a designated point between specific times. The discharge of these duties must not be to the detriment of the welfare of other road users.

Profile

You will supervise the safe passage of school children and other pedestrians who are accompanying them, in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulations.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

The post holder will ensure the safe passage of school children.

Maintain control over pedestrians who are awaiting your instructions to cross.

As part of your role you will be responsible for deciding when it is safe to stop traffic, using the crossing patrol sign, to give clear signals to drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians.

It is essential for you to have a knowledge of Road Safety and to possess good communication skills.

At times, you may be required to liaise with the school and the police to assist in reporting accidents and other incidents at the crossing site.

Report any problems or difficulties to the school office.

Scope for Impact

This post provides support for the school, students and parents liaising with officials as necessary to improve services and outcomes for children, young people and their families and carers.

General

This job only contains the main duties relating to this post and does not describe in detail the tasks required to carry them out. This job description may be amended at any time following discussion between the line manager and member of staff and may be reviewed annually.

Work Demands

Able to work to strict deadlines but also be flexible to deal with changing priorities and unforeseen circumstances which could be lengthy to resolve.

Ensure that strict confidentiality is maintained at all times.

Normal physical effort required.

The post holder will work in all weather conditions

Full uniform and high visibility equipment will be provided
