
Dear Colleague,



OUR JOURNEY SO FAR

MHA was one of seven sponsored academies that were opened as part of the programme to transform educational provision within selected communities across Manchester.

2009

Manchester Health Academy opens, succeeding Brookway High School

2010

The Academy moves into a £20 million state-of-the-art building with capacity for 600 students

2015

The Academy acquires part of Brooklands Public Library, and opens "The Hub", and adds an all-weather 3G pitch to its sports facility.

2016

The Academy is asked to increase student numbers, and offers an additional 90 student places in each successive Year 7, with a view to an eventual total of 1100. A major extension project is embarked upon, beginning with the Dining Room.

2017

A new FA Standard 3G Football Pitch is opened, offering additional high-quality sports opportunities to both students and the wider community.

2018

The Academy opens a major extension to its teaching and learning facilities, the final piece of the £10 million development project. It includes 15 brand new teaching rooms, and additional specialist rooms for ICT, Food Technology and Science.

2019

A dedicated Careers Resource Room is opened.

£1.2 million refurbishment of the Community Sports Centre
