CURRENCY

Desborough College delivers a rich, ambitious and broad curriculum. This, combined with high-quality teaching and intelligent assessment practices, students benefit from an exciting, enriching and engaging education. We know that through this, pupils will meet and exceed their academic potential and develop knowledge and skills across a broad range of subjects.

CULTURE

We have high expectations when it comes to student behaviour as we know that anything less will prevent them and others from fulfilling their academic and personal aspirations. We follow three simple rules which contribute to the positive student culture we have here at Desborough. We have a unique CPD offer that dedicates a large amount of time for professional development for all staff. This training is provided both internally by Desborough staff, through external partners and through time dedicated to self-directed learning.

As part of our CPD calendar we dedicate a significant amount of time for staff to meet in department teams. We know that time to work collaboratively with colleagues supports planning and teaching in a workload-conscious way which is of the utmost importance to us.


