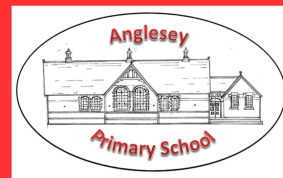


Deputy Head Teacher Information Sheet

- Ensure high-quality teaching across EYFS and Key Stage 1

- Lead and strengthen transition into and through the Infant phase
- Contribute to improving teaching and outcomes across the school

Organisational Effectiveness (Success)

- Lead the day-to-day operation of the Infant Building
- Oversee staffing, safeguarding, systems and site routines
- Ensure consistency, structure and high expectations across the phase

Strategic Leadership (Whole-School Responsibility)

- Lead agreed areas of the Ofsted framework across the whole school (e.g. Quality of Education, Behaviour & Attitudes, Personal Development or Leadership & Management – to be confirmed)
