# Dear applicant,

Thank you for taking the time to find out more about Long Sutton County Primary School and considering joining our team as our Deputy Head Teacher.

We are a large, rural South Lincolnshire Primary School with inquisitive and well behaved children. Our vision at Long Sutton CP School is that all our pupils are confident and persistent in pursuit of high aspirations; and are taught through a stimulating and varied curriculum. We are constantly seeking to develop our provision, have created a self funded Additional Needs Group and built up the use



of our extensive grounds as part of outdoor learning. This includes extending lessons from the classrooms, building Pudding Lane and recreating the Great Fire of London, re-enacting a Viking boat burning or using the school's tents for a whole year group camp out. For us, it is important that we continue this approach despite the recent pandemic whilst promoting achievement for all children.

Long Sutton County Primary is an innovative school and has consistently demonstrated this in the approaches we have taken and the appointments we have made over recent years. We have also earned the trust and praise of our local community for how we have supported children and families during the pandemic. The school has an excellent record of staff CPD, wellbeing and retention which means that we are in a good position to develop over coming years to meet the challenges caused by Covid-19.

The school was one of the Founder Schools of the Keystone Academy Trust in November 2019. Our membership of Keystone is a central part of our school improvement work with a strategic training programme for subject and school leaders. Our current Assistant Head Teacher has been promoted to join the Central Team of Keystone Academy Trust in a learning and teaching role and will not be applying for this role. He will be working on a 0.5 basis during next academic year before leaving his current role in July 2022.

As a school, we have developed leadership internally over recent years and this is an opportunity to look outwards for a new deputy who will have a proven track record of excellence both inside and outside the classroom and be expected to take forward the tremendous work in the school, particularly in regard to teaching and learning, curriculum, staff development and assessment. High expectations are key to the role as well as a commitment to inclusive education, so that all of our pupils can achieve. Our new Deputy also needs to have the ability to lead teams with care and confidence.
