



Radcliffe on Trent Junior School Information

Our school is a Nottinghamshire local authority maintained school, which was graded 'Good' during our Ofsted inspection in April 2023. Situated in a large, busy village 6 miles east of Nottingham in the borough of Rushcliffe, we are one of three schools in the village. We are committed to working closely with Radcliffe-on-Trent Infant and Nursery school and South Nottinghamshire Academy. Our school is very outward facing and works collaboratively within many different partnerships, including the Rushcliffe Schools Alliance.

We currently have 335 children on roll in twelve classes.

We are very proud of our high academic standards and inclusive school ethos, which is based on being a caring and aspirational school, where we value everyone as an individual. We are committed to the development of the whole child and have a holistic educational approach. This lies at the heart of our curriculum, which offers broad, rich and relevant learning experiences for all of our children.

We offer a large and diverse range of extra-curricular activities including many sporting, music and art events and competitions. Our school was the first school in Rushcliffe to be awarded the School Games Platinum Sports Award for inclusion and participation in sport. We are also proud of our Eco Green Flag award and Music Mark. Many educational visits are arranged for our children to support the curriculum throughout the year. We have residential trips in Year 4 and Year 6, as well as numerous visits to enrich our termly topics.

Positive pupil voice is very important to us at our school. As well as representing peers on our pupil council, we also invite representatives from across all pupil groups to be part of the following: Eco committee, Art committee, Sports council and our Reading Ambassador team. Issues are discussed and children feel they make a valuable contribution to our curriculum and school community. Our team of ABC's (Anti-Bullying Champions) also play an active role in making sure our playtimes feel happy and safe.

We value working in partnership with our families and the wider community. We welcome support from parents and carers, including help with a variety of activities in school. Our supportive PTA (PATHS) also helps raise funds and organises social events.
