We are consistently oversubscribed and are very well thought of in the local community. The Sixth Form has 130 students, but we are expecting this to grow as more of our Year 11 students stay on into Sixth Form. We have had extensive investment in Sixth Form facilities from Bishop Bewick Catholic Education Trust with a new £2.5million Sixth Form Centre opening in the summer term of 2025.
